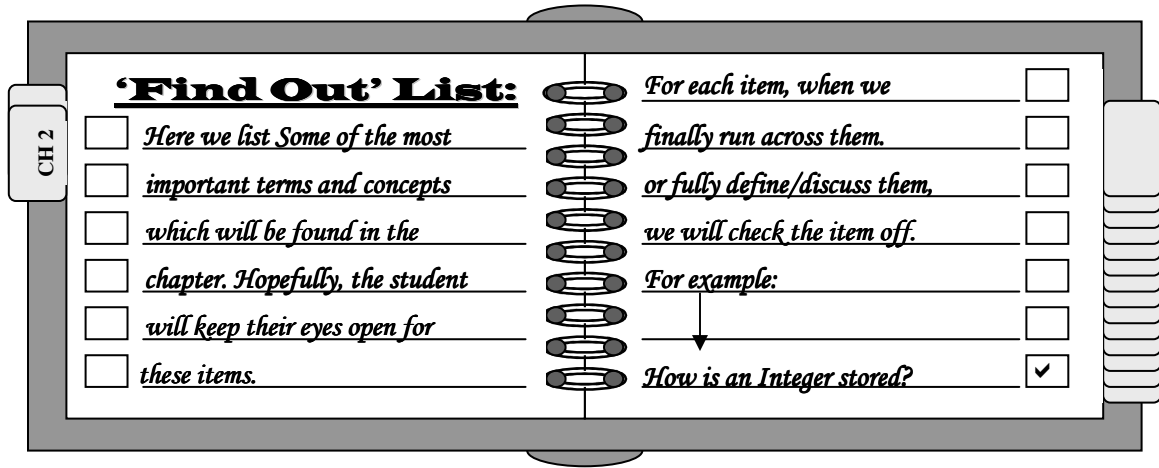


## Conventions Used in This Text
